



# LAWN CARE 101



## Step 1 – Prepare your Lawn

Cut your grass with a low cut or scalp to help thin out the thick blanket of grass from the winter months.

## Step 2 - Dethatch

Loosens the dead decomposing grass.



## Step 3 – Mow or Blow

Mow lawn with bag to pick up thatch or blow the thatch off with a Push or Backpack Blower.



## Step 4 - Aerate

An Aerator creates little mouths for the soil to receive the necessary ingredients (oxygen, food and water).



## Step 5 – Fertilize and Weed and Feed

Use a spreader to feed your newly aerated lawn the food it needs.

## Step 6 - Water

Use a hose, sprinkler or water storage tank to make sure you can water the entire lawn.



## Step 7 - Mow

Mowing once a week is crucial for your lawn. Ideal height for most grasses is between 2 ½” to 3 ½”. Please research what is best for your type of grass. Clippings can be bagged or placed in a compost pile.

## Step 8 Edge, Trim and Blow

Edging, Trimming (weed eat) and Blowing your unwanted grass allows for a finished look.
